BROWN

... ESTANCIAS



Dos Talas

Built by Pedro Luro in the XIX century, Dos Talas is one of the most important estancias in Argentina. Its magnificent 40 hectare (98 acres) park, designed by Carlos Thays, surrounds the main house. Its chapel, a replica of a French chapel, contains works of art of French origin. Its library, with more than 3,000 Spanish, French and Italian books published during the XVIII, XIX and XX century, is one of the most important ones.



LOCATION

Dolores, 204 km (127 miles) south from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

4 rooms: 1 suite and 3 rooms with shared bathrooms.

PRODUCTION

Agriculture and cattle production.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Horseback riding, cycling, 'volanta' or 'sulky' guided rides and swimming.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Flights in glider planes from the Aero Club, kayaking and sailing in Dolores lagoon.

MEALS

Barbecue (beef, lamb and pork) and local specialties. Home made cakes and desserts.

El Ombú de Areco

The magnificent Italian style farmhouse, built in 1890 by General Richieri, is surrounded by 300 hectares (740 acres) of fields.



LOCATION

San Antonio de Areco, 110 km (68 miles) north from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

6 rooms with private bathroom.

PRODUCTION

Mainly cattle breeding and agriculture.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Swimming, horseback riding, old carriage riding, football and farm work watching.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Golf links and tennis courts in San Antonio de Areco Club. Visit to San Antonio de Areco and Ricardo Güiraldes Museum.

MEALS

International dishes and local specialties.

La Candelaria Polo Club

La Candelaria is one of the best places in Argentina to play polo, from beginners up to professional players. All the necessary equipment and polo ponies are ready for a great experience. The 100 hectares park was designed by the famous Carlos Thays, with centennial araucarias, palm trees, casuarinas, ombues among others, that circle the splendid Normand Castle.



LOCATION

Lobos, 130 km (80 miles) west from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

Bungalows in the woods, Dutch windmill and Colonial cottages, Classical & Standard rooms in the castle, Castle's Candelaria and Real Suites.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Swimming pool, horseback riding, carriages, tennis, soccer, volley ball, cycling, billiard, table tennis and guided tour of the farm, castle and chape.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Golf course.

El Rosario de Areco

El Rosario de Areco is a colonial style estancia whose main house was built in 1892. It has an extense park of 14 hectares (34 acres) with a great variety of trees, such as the centenary 'Ubaja', brought from Entre Ríos province by the current owners' ancestors.



LOCATION

San Antonio de Areco, 110 km (68 miles) North from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

2 comfortable apartments for 2 or 3 people with private bathroom and heating. 6 double rooms with private bathroom.

PRODUCTION

This estancia dedicates its 148 hectares (365 acres) to agriculture and specially to breeding and training polo horses.

ACTIVITIES

Horseback riding, sulky riding, biking, swimming, strolls around the main house and the stables, polo demonstrations and lessons.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Golf and tennis courts in San Antonio de Areco Club and excursions to San Antonio de Areco.

MEALS

Barbques, home-made dishes and international cuisine. Vegetarian menu.

Los Patricios

Exclusive gaucho 'parties' are organized in this deluxe estancia. This property was owned by the founder of San Antonio de Areco and is nowadays run by one of its descendants. One of the main attractions in Los Patricios is its impressive main house area, formed by an imposing 40 acre park, a natural lake, barns, stables, polo field and carriage driving paths.



LOCATION

San Antonio de Areco, 100 km (63 miles) northwest from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

The day includes a reception cocktail, barbecue under the trees, horseback riding, driving in vintage carriages and bird watching. Guests can also enjoy the other facilities that include the swimming pool, tennis, volleyball and soccer courts.

Juan Gerónimo

Juan Gerónimo is a traditional Tudor-style estancia founded in 1920. Its 4,000 hectares (9,884 acres) are located in a World Natural Biosphere Reserve declared by UNESCO, overlooking Samborombón Bay. A wide variety of wildlife can be observed: axis deers, white herons, royal lapwings, and various other bird species.



LOCATION

Verónica, 165 km (102 miles) south from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

MAIN BUILDING

8 rooms with 6 bathrooms. Guest's House: 3 rooms with 1 bathroom.

PRODUCTION

Agriculture and cattle breeding

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Horseback riding, carriage riding, mountain bike expeditions to sand dunes, mud flats and lakes. Paddle-tennis, trekking, fishing, bird watching and rural activities.

MEALS

Local and international cuisine.

La Isolina

Located on the banks of Tapalqué river at the foot of Olavarría Hills, La Isolina's english style main house was built in 1920 and its furniture has remained the same since then. A 10 hectare (24 acres) park surrounds the main building.



LOCATION

Colonia Hinojo, 350 km (217 miles) southwest from downtown Buenos Aires, near Olavarría.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

6 rooms with 3 bathrooms.

PRODUCTION

Agriculture and cattle production, specially Hereford.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Participation in the rural activities, carriage rides, bird watching, canoeing and fishing in the stream. Swimming, and tennis (grass tennis court).

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

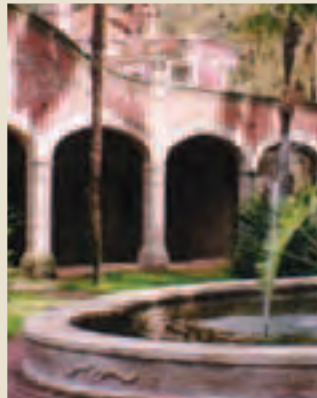

Santa Rita

A large park surrounded by a 40 hectares (98 acres) centennial wood is the setting for the architecture of the main house, built in Victorian style. The living-room with its burning fireplace and the reading corners offers views of the outstanding park and creates a warm and private atmosphere. The park, with its large avenues of varied species, is ideal for horseback or carriage riding.



LOCATION

Lobos, 130 km (80 miles) west from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

9 rooms with private bathroom.

PRODUCTION

Agriculture and cattle production.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Horseback riding, carriage riding, swimming, walking, cycling, bird watching, participating in rural activities: milking and orchard.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Visit Lobos Lagoon, Juan Domingo Perón Museum, Nuestra Señora del Carmen Church, Pulpería La Estrella, golf and fishing.

MEALS

Traditional Argentine barbecue. Home made cuisine and international dishes.

La Concepción

This estancia was founded at the beginning of the XIX century. The main house was built in French style. The guesthouse, has a large sleeping room with changing room and showers. There are more than 200 hectares (494 acres) of a superb park and a great neogothic chapel. La Concepción is famous for its polo tradition. The polo fields, are available for those who enjoy this sport.

LOCATION

120 km (74 miles) west from downtown Buenos Aires, in Lobos County.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

27 rooms. Main house: 9 rooms with en-suite bathroom. Chalet: 2 suites of two rooms, 2 simple rooms and a room with 8 beds. Small House: 4 rooms and 2 bathrooms.

PRODUCTION

Agriculture and cattle production.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walks, horseback riding, carriage riding, swimming, football, tennis, paddle and farm work watching.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Golf in Lobos (10 km / 6 miles from the estancia) and water sports in Lobos Lagoon.

Fishing and hunting excursions can be arranged upon request.

Bella Vista de Guerrero

Bella Vista traces its origins back to an initial distribution of lands to the south of the Salado, between the paths of the Callejón and La Postrema in 1804. In 1825, the lands are conceded to Don Félix de Àlzaga, who receives them from Don Juan Manuel de Rosas as retribution for his performance as Jefe de Regimiento. After Don Félix's death, in 1841, his son Martín de Àlzaga inherits them. He is the grandson of the Martín de Àlzaga who headed the conspiracy against the revolutionary Mayo government and who was executed and hanged in 1812.



LOCATION

Guerrero - Castelli, 168 km (104 miles) south from downtown Buenos Aires (route N°2).

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

Main House: 13 rooms with private bathroom
Farm House: 4 rooms with private bathroom
Convention Center

PRODUCTION

Agriculture and cattle production.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Outdoor swimming pool, tennis, football, volley, horseback riding, cycling, "volanta" or "sulky", guided walks along the park and woodland with recognition of the "flora", trekking, fishing at the Salado river and rural activities. Spa (sauna, Skilful Scot, hidromassage and massages). Interpretation Center. Games room.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Villa María

Villa María's imposing Norman Tudor style main house was built at the beginning of the century by the well-known architect Bustillo. Its large living room, the dining room, the lounge and the billiard room are all tastefully furnished. A splendid 110 acre park with varied species and sculptures designed by Charles Thays surrounds the main house.



LOCATION

Máximo Paz, 47 km (29 miles) southwest from downtown Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

Main house: 5 suite two bedrooms and 1 suite one bedroom. Guest's house: 1 suite three bedrooms, 2 rooms with private bathroom (en suite) and 2 rooms with bathroom.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walks, horseback riding, cycling, swimming, tennis and croquet.

MEALS

Local home-made meals and international dishes.

LOCATION

San Pablo Farm is located in San Miguel del Monte, 100 km away from Buenos Aires.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

Standard (maximum 3 adults): equipped with private bathroom, balcony with panoramic scenery on to the park design by landscape gardener Charles Thays. These bedrooms can be communicate internally, which means they are usually much asked by families that require two bedrooms communicated in-between.

Shack (maximum capacity 4 adults): house located at 200 mts from the principal one. Formed by two bedrooms .

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Excursion to Perito Moreno and Upsala glaciers, fishing, visit to El Calafate town.

La Oriental

Within Perito Moreno National Park, surrounded by mountains and lakes, this estancia is set in an area where the glacial valleys have beautiful rivers and lakes. The local fauna, such as condors, can be observed permanently.



LOCATION

Perito Moreno National Park, 1,000 meters (half a mile) from Belgrano Lake, in Santa Cruz Province.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

3 triple rooms, 1 double room and 2 rooms with a double bed plus one single bed. All with private bathroom.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Horseback riding, trekking, camping at San Lorenzo Hill and Posadas Lake.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Trekking, horseback riding.

MEALS

Home-made dishes, Patagonian specialties including asado (Argentine barbecue).

LOCATION

In the lands of the legendary Estancia Anita, near Argentino Lake, 35 km from (22 miles) El Calafate.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

6 double rooms with private bathroom and 1 suite (total capacity: 15 people).

PRODUCTION

Breed and development of the ovine cattle.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walking, horseback riding, trekking, bicycling, farm work watching, visit to Estancia Anita and its shearing quarters.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Fishing in Argentino Lake, excursions to Perito

Moreno Glacier, and Upsala and Onelli Glaciers. Photographic safaris.

La Elvira

Situated in a superb location with amazing panoramic viewpoints that outlook over the Caleta Valdés, amid unspoilt countryside and furnished to very high standards.

LOCATION

180 km from Puerto Madryn, 80 km from Puerto Pirámide.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

MAIN BUILDING

8 double comfortable rooms with private bathroom and central heating.

PRODUCTION

Sheep breeding.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walk along self-guided footpaths and observe the abundant fauna and flora species that grow in the region. Not less remarkable, the important rookery of southern elephant seals that lie along 10 kilometres of coast and the newly created colony of Magellanic penguins will make your stroll even more enjoyable. Horseback riding, photographic safari, rides in horse-drawn carts, mountain bike, palaeontologist and archaeologist interest excursions, sheep-shearing, handling of sheep with sheepdogs and the traditional



earmarking, watching of day-to-day farm activities, stars observation with or without lecture given by astronomy professional, birding.

LOCATION

At the foot of south Mt Catedral, at the southern end of Gutiérrez Lake, 25 km south from Bariloche.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

We have a capacity for 30 beds in 12 suites with view to the lake, distributed in 2 houses and 2 log cabins.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Trekking, guided horseback riding, paddling in duckies (inflatable kayaks), climbing, fly fishing, dinghy, mountain ropes, live concerts at our non-denominational temple, massage, Tai Chi, Yoga, meditations, wine tasting, nature walks, birding, fly fishing. Cattle-raising. In the farmhouse and surrounding area shearing and branding will show you through the history and true life of the Patagonian farmer.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Enjoy the natural beauty of its wilderness: thousands of elephant seals that mate and have their offspring, sea lions, watch the Southern Franca Whale and Orcas swimming by, Patagonia hare or mara, guanacos, grey foxes, the Patagonian pichi, armadillos, lizards, skunks, European hare, the small cuis and birding (on the steppe: Choique, the Southern goldfinch, herons,



turkey buzzards, owls, calandra larks; on breakwaters and the Atlantic coast: seagulls, cormorants, the Antarctic doves, oystercatcher, swallows, flamingos and ducks among others.

Helsingfors

This estancia was built on the memories of the ranch founded at the turn of the century by the Finnish adventurer Alfred Ramstron.



LOCATION

On the southern margin of Viedma Lake, within Los Glaciares National Park, 150 kms (93 miles) from El Calafate.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

6 double and 2 triple rooms, with private bathroom. Total capacity: 18 people.

PRODUCTION

Ovine cattle.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walking, trekking, horseback riding (on request), farm work watching, lake excursions and fauna watching.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Sailing to Viedma glacier, trekking or horseback riding to Blue Lagoon, sailing to Bahía Túnel, trekking in El Chaltén.

Hostería Antigua Patagonia

Antigua Patagonia is located at the shore of the majestic Lago Buenos Aires, of 2,400 km² (926 sq. miles), in Los Antiguos, a town located in the northeast of Santa Cruz province. Framed by the imposing Andes Range, it offers an ideal scenery to enjoy a unique stay in Patagonia.



LOCATION

Los Antiguos, in the northeast of Santa Cruz province.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

16 comfortable rooms with splendid panoramic views of the lake and the Andes.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Excursions to the Cave of the Painted Hands, San Lorenzo Hill, Chile, Chico-Rio Baker and Puerto Yungay.

El Chaltén, Santa Cruz Province, 213 km (132 miles) from El Calafate

4 double rooms and 4 triple rooms with private bathroom.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walking, trekking, horseback riding and fishing.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SURROUNDING AREA

Excursions to 'Laguna de los Tres', 'Laguna Torre', 'Laguna Capri', 'Glaciar Piedras Blancas', 'Río Eléctrico'. Trekking to the Continental icefield and trekking over Torre Glacier.

La Maipú

La Maipú stands on the imposing Andes Range, by the shore of the turquoise waters of San Martín Lake. Run by the Leyenda family for half a century, while walking along its visitors are impressed by the panoramic views of Fitz Roy and Torre Mountain Chains, as well as Mt. Astillado.

On the southern shore of San Martín Lake, Maipu Peninsula and Doble Island. Area 240 km (149 miles) from El Chaltén and 280 km (173 miles) from El Calafate, Santa Cruz Province.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walking, trekking, horseback riding, 4WD vehicles driving, mountain bike, birdwatching, photographic safaris and farm work watching.

Excursions to Mt. Astillado, Doble Island, 'Laguna del Desierto', Los Glaciares National Park.

Río Baker (Chile)

An attractive lodge built over piles by the shore of Bertrand Lake, giving you the feeling of being suspended on the lake.

LOCATION

Approximately 300 km (186 miles) away from Perito Moreno in Santa Cruz province.

Bordering Buenos Aires lake towards Chile Chico, first Chilean settlement on the border along the shore of the lake (named General Carreras in Chile), up to the beginning of Baker River. Also accessible through Baker-Roballos border pass.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

4 double rooms with private bathroom and central dining room.

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Walking, trekking and fishing (brown and rainbow trouts).



Colome

Few places on earth remain untouched in their natural beauty – Estancia Colome, with its 96,000 acres (39,000 ha), of land, is one of them. Colomé was farmed for thousands of years by native Indians who were excellent stewards of the land. As the tale goes, the Indian chief Colomin received vines from the Spanish conquistadores in the late 16th century for good services rendered. The old Colomé winery was founded in 1831, probably by the last Spanish governor of Salta, Nicolás Severo de Isasmendi y Echarlar. In 1854, his daughter Ascensión, married José Benjamín Dávalos, and introduced pre-phyloxera Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon vines to Colomé from France. Three vineyards dating from this time still produce grapes. Colomé is considered the oldest working winery in Argentina.

LOCATION

Northwest of the province of Salta, 220 km (137 miles) from Salta. Colomé lies nestled in the foothills, 2-3 hours from Cafayate and 2 hours from Cachi.

PRODUCTION

The three Colomé vineyards are situated in the west (Colomé Vineyards), the north ("El Arenal"), and the south ("La Brava") of the beautiful 200-km-long (124 miles) Calchaquí Valley. The main vineyards extend between an altitude of 2200 – 3015 m (Colomé and El Arenal), (7218 – 9892 ft), these are therefore the highest vineyards in the world, as the world's second-highest vineyard in Nepal is planted at 2750 m (9022 ft).

Biodynamic Agriculture helps establish a relationship with nature, food and the economy.

Currently, the contributions of ecological agriculture are being sought with great interest for the garden, farming and livestock production. Wholesome, free-from-toxic-waste foods, as well as safe practices for the environment are anxiously sought. Livestock farming in an organic environment is closely associated with agriculture, even entirely unthinkable without it, as agriculture is similarly unsustainable without the use of animals.

ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

7 junior suites & 2 master suites

ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTANCIA

Swimming pool, walking and jogging trails, tennis court, putting green and a bocci ball court. Horse back riding, rambles, 'Asado' sited to provide the best views, visits to our 160 ha large biodynamic farm, animal stables as well as

herb & vegetable garden. Lectures are held on a weekly basis for those interested in learning more about biodynamic agriculture.

ACCOMMODATION SURROUNDING AREA

Visits to our neighbouring fincas such as Tacuil and Amaicha.



House of Jasmines

The House of Jasmines is a faithful reflection of this elegant stately home. More than a hundred years old, it opens its doors today as a magnificent Inn which sits on 300 acres, surrounded by the charm of nature. You will be delighted by the entrance to "one-hundred-year-old tree avenue", a ditch which runs across the field, the Arenales River which borders the Ranch field, a wall made 100 mts high poles, and a plethora of jasmines mingling with heavy vegetation. It is a remote place on Earth, though it is far more than that.
