## Classic

It is an unforgettable experience, as well as sailing along the Argentino Lake to approach Upsala Glacier, the greatest continental glacier in the Southern Hemisphere.

Breakfast. Bus trip to Perito Moreno Glacier, one of the world's largest active continental glaciers, declared World Heritage site by Unesco because of its breathtaking beauty and its unusual behavior. Return to El Calafate. Dinner. Accommodation.

**DAY 04 EL CALAFATE**  
Breakfast. Transfer to El Calafate airport.

**Optional tours:**  
Torres del Paine, Fitz Roy, Helsingfors or half day El Galpón, which offer its visitors the opportunity to attend a "live" sheep shaving.

**DAY 01 USHUAIA**  
Breakfast. Reception at Ushuaia airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. In the afternoon, city tour including a visit to the End of the World Museum. Dinner.

**DAY 02 USHUAIA**  
Breakfast. Half day sailing across the Beagle Channel. While sailing the Ushuaia Bay, you will be able to see the southernmost city in the world, to finally arrive in a small key where the famous Les Eclaireurs lighthouse stands. On the way back, we will pass by the sea lions and the Birds islands. Return to the Hotel. Dinner.

**DAY 03 USHUAIA**  
Breakfast. Departure to Tierra del Fuego National Park, located only 12 km (7.5 miles) away from the city. It preserves typical species of the Andean-Patagonian Forest spread in an area of 155,670 acres. Before entering the National Park you will board the Train to the End of the World and enjoy an unforgettable trip along the original railroad where the old prisoners' train run until 1947. The highlight of the park is Lapataia Bay, the southernmost tip of the continent, where you will be able to appreciate a wonderful view of the Beagle Channel. Return to hotel. Dinner.

**DAY 04 USHUAIA**  
Breakfast. Transfer to Ushuaia airport.

Before entering the National Park you will board the Train to the End of the World to enjoy an unforgettable trip along the original embankment where the old prisoners' train run until 1947. The highlight of the park is Lapataia Bay the southernmost tip of the continent, where you will be able to appreciate a wonderful view of the Beagle Channel. In the afternoon sail across the Beagle Channel. While sailing the Ushuaia Bay you will be able to see the southernmost city in the world, to lately arrive at the small key where the famous Les Eclaireurs lighthouse is located. On the way back we will pass by the sea lions and the Birds islands. Return to the Hotel. Dinner.
