



Ski weeks and short ski trips

There are several ski resorts throughout the Andes: Cerro Castor in Ushuaia, Las Leñas in the province of Mendoza, Chapelco in San Martin de los Andes and Cerro Catedral in Bariloche.

Cerro Catedral
The resort is located in the Nahuel Huapi National Park in a unique location bordered by lakes, mountains and pine forests. Ski and snowboard lovers find in Catedral the most extensive skiable surface of South America: over 2,964 acres (1,200 hectares), half of which comprises prepared runs, while the other half is off-piste terrain with breath-taking views and exciting adventure! The Resort has more than 1,482 acres (600 hectares) of east-facing slopes suitable for skiing, with an excellent blanket of snow from early June to early October, and enjoying full daily light exposition. Its direct and close-to-base access to runs makes of Catedral a unique resort, with the most complete facilities on Base, which is at

3,380 ft. (1,030m) above sea level. The maximum reachable height above sea level, at 6,892 ft. (2,100 m), offers one of the most impressive views of the Andes mountain chain. There are 30 lifts with a capacity of 22,000 people per hour, and a professional team of patrollers and aides specialized in mountain rescue techniques. The weather is extremely dry with predominant winds from the southeast, averaging between -2°C (12.5°F) and 12°C (75°F). While the average snowfall in the summit is of 6 mts and in the base is of 1.5 mts, the complex has an integral snow-making system that covers an approximate area of 25 acres (10 hectares) and goes from Mountain Base to Platform 1200 lift.

In case you are tired of skiing you can also mix the sport with day trips to Campanario Hill, San Pedro and Llao Llao Peninsulas, Victoria Island, or even the Seven Lakes Road to San Martin de los Andes passing by Villa La Angostura.

DAY 01 BUENOS AIRES

Reception at the airport and transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, city tour of Buenos Aires. We will visit some of the most interesting places, such as: Plaza de Mayo (Mayo Square), Casa Rosada (Government Pink House), the Cabildo (Old City Hall), the Metropolitan Cathedral, Mayo Avenue, the Congress Palace, Colón Theatre, La Boca, San Telmo, Palermo and Recoleta neighborhoods. A great first glance of the city on your arrival day to assess what this cosmopolitan city has to offer. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 02 BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning transfer to Martindale Country Club, located less than one hour from the city. This wonderful golf course was inaugurated in 1989. It is a 72 par course of 6,900 yards, which constitutes one of the best trails in Argentina, not only for its exquisite design that keeps the essence of an old park, but also for the beauty of the place and the excellent field maintenance which is the club highlight. Lunch will be served at the Club House, afterwards you will play an 18-hole Medal Play Tournament. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 03 BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning transfer to the Jockey Club de San Isidro, a nationwide well known club full of history and tradition. The challenging red course was designed by Mr. Allister Mackenzie, and hosted the most important tournaments, such as the Republic Open, the World Cup, the European Tour and the amateurs' championships. In the afternoon, we will enjoy lunch at the Club House. After an 18 hole round you will realize why great players like Arnold Palmer, Sam Snead, Tom Watson, Gary Player, Craig Stadler, Byron Nelson and Jack Nicklaus so strongly recommend this course. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 04 BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning we will drive to a traditional estancia (ranch) in the outskirts of the city where you will spend a full

day enjoying a gaucho party. This is the perfect way to take a rest from the great number of activities you are taking part in and spend a marvelous day enjoying nature and culture. During lunch time we will taste a delicious 'asado' (Argentine barbecue), and during the afternoon we will enjoy a folklore show with live music, dancing and a tango demonstration, followed by 'cuadras' and ring races where gauchos show their skills as riders. For those willing to participate in traditional activities, there are horses and 'sulkies' (two-wheeled carts) to go around in the ranch. Later on, a snack consisting of home-made pastries and 'mate' (green tea) will be served. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 05 BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, transfer to Olivos Golf Club. This is a beautiful golf course, whose main characteristic is the undulating land planted with old trees, where accuracy and patience are required. After having lunch at the Club House you will participate in an 18 hole Medal Play Tournament, where you will be able to show your best skills. This course has been the scenery for the Masters Tournament for 14 consecutive years. Numerous golf stars, such as Payne Stewart, Bernard Langher, Gary Player, Robert de Vicenzo, Vicente Fernández and Craig Stadler have played here. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 06 BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. This will be the last day for you to play and enjoy a great time practicing golf. An excellent opportunity to farewell Argentine golf courses. Today's challenge is going to take place in the course of your preference: Hurlingham Golf Course or Highland Park Country Club. In both cases, you will arrive at midday and enjoy a delicious meal at the Club House. The first 9 holes of Hurlingham Club were inaugurated in 1892 and the second 9 holes, in 1922. As it was often the case with English golf courses, it was built near railway stations. It is a 71 par course of 6,349 yards. As it was usual at that time,

the golf courses were characterized by its small and quick greens and narrow fairways. It was host of the Republic Open in various opportunities and of the most important tournaments of the Amateurs' Ranking. Highland Park Club is one of the most demanding courses in Buenos Aires. A clear example is that it is a 72 par course but it is qualified as 73.8, this is due to its length (almost 7,000 yards), its countless obstacles (streets and water hazards in most of its holes) and its speedy holes. It is a beautiful golf course with a great maintenance. Therefore, apart from its difficulty, it deserves to host the most important tournaments of the Argentine ranking of amateur golfers. As you can see, both golf courses for the day where chosen carefully for you to have a memorable last game. At night, you will assist to an unforgettable tango show performed by the best dancers and singers, while enjoying a delicious meal. This constitutes the perfect way to leave Buenos Aires, the city of tango. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 07 BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport.
